OJAI MIDYEAR'S REPORT

The operational year running from Q3 2017 to Q3 2018 was characterised by a significant evolution of the OJAI project. Our field-trip to Dallas culminated in the installation and operation of a temporary office at RO2 in the Cedars district of the city. The office was inaugurated with a live performance and radio broadcast entitled General Audit 1. The motivation for the Texas expedition was to attend the opening of A Hard Place, an exhibition featuring the OJAI at 500X, a collaboration with the University of Texas and Berlin's Laura Mars Gallery. A development with long-term consequences occurring in Dallas was the appointment of OJAI as foreign correspondents for the Sonic Assembly radio show with Reid Robinson and Mark Ridlen on KUZU 92.9 fm.

The midyear period also saw OJAI's first institutional exhibitions — Marres Currents #5 at the Centre for Contemporary Culture in Maastricht curated by Evelyn Simmons and Isabel van Bos. This was followed by State of State-lessness at ISELP in Brussels curated by Alicja Melzacka, Hilde Borgermans, Maxime Gourdon and Romuald Demidenko. Both engagements involved OJAI exhibiting postal correspondence, video work and map installations as well as performances General Audit 2 and Red Tape Lottery.


OJAI participated in the exhibition, performance program and publication entitled Letters of Last Resort at Damien & The Love Guru in Brussels. The project was curated by Padraic E.Moore and featured work by Desk Zero, Liam Gillick, Jenny Holzer, Mark Lombardi and others with scenography by Parasite 2.0. The publication was produced in Berlin with the assistance of OJAI.

Later still in the summer of 2018 OJAI participated in a three-month residency at AIR Antwerpen culminating in the performance premiere of White Paper on the Abolition of Tunnels (or Tunnel Lottery for short). An OJAI video work and a slightly adapted Tunnel Lottery later travelled to Cologne for the BAU036 group show at Gold + Beton.

In September OJAI contributed a performative lecture to the I AM DYNAMITE symposium on disagreement in public space curated by Roisin Agnew at The Complex Center as part of the Dublin Fringe Festival. As of Q3 2018 the OJAI prepares for its most ambitious project to date: THE EUROPEAN CONFERENCE OF INSTITUTIONAL IDEATORS focusing on Self-Institutionalisation as artistic Strategy hosted by the OJAI at Groelle Pass:projects in Wuppertal on October 19 and 20 in 2019. At the time of writing confirmed contributors for the conference were: The Department for Ultimology (Dublin), T.A.L.O.S. (Brussels), Vanja Smiljanic, Minister of Cosmic People for the countries of Ex-Yugoslavia, Portugal and former Portugese colonies (Cologne), Merle Vorwald (Berlin), Padraic E.Moore (Brussels), Julia Zinnbauer (Düsseldorf), Jan Jelinek (Berlin), That Might Be Right (Brussels), Donna Marie O'Donovan (Dublin) and Tea Palmelund (Berlin).











DEXIA DEFUNCT

The name Dexia defunct goes back to the very beginning of our work together, the period before the foundation of the Office for Joint Administrative Intelligence. The first day we spent together we went on an architectural walking tour of Brussels with a focus on the real-estate portfolio of the defunct Dexia bank corporation in the Forbidden Zone. Of particular interest that day was the abandoned office building with gold glass and brown concrete support pillars at Rue de la Ligne. We took pinhole photographs and made sound recordings. Out of that arose a musical collaboration: Dexia Defunct. It includes recorded noises processed and mixed with electronic sounds from a Doepfer modular system and a repetitive administrative voice. A Best-Of cassette tape was released in 2016 as part of our Fruit Solutions exhibition at Laura Mars Gallery in Berlin. We performed as Dexia defunct for several months at bars and seedy club venues such as Bei Ruth in Berlin Neukölln and the legendary Bokal Royale in Brussels. The Office for Joint Administrative Intelligence was founded as a consequence of this enterprise.

For all intents and purposes OJAI has completely subsumed Dexia Defunct This year - by the time of the destruction of the building on Rue de la Ligne - the OJAI reintroduced the name Dexia Defunct as a record label while the building is still prominent in our logo. Dexia Defunct publishes vinyl records of sonic research created under the auspices of the OJAI Political and Infrastructural Sound Archive PISA. At the time of writing it has published four 7-inch vinyl records pressed as single copies for use in OJAI performances.
