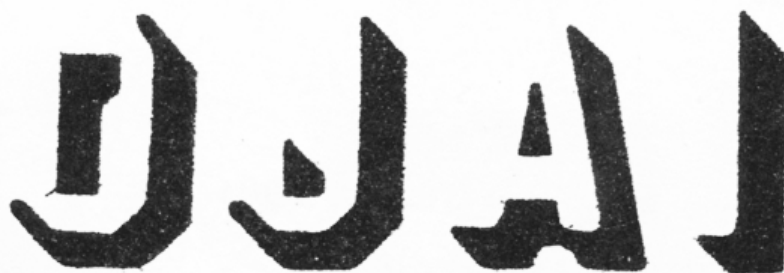

EMERGENCY REPORT

2020 was characterized by extremely difficult operating conditions across all sectors of cultural, social, and economic activity. The Office for Joint Administrative Intelligence was deeply affected by travel restrictions, border closures, curfews, event cancellations and compulsory medical examinations which rendered our performative program largely unworkable. In April, we convened a Pandemic Summit in Berlin to discuss contingency plans and strategies to offset the destructive effects of the emergency. The resulting 'Emergency Declaration' signed on April 5th emphasized strategies to maintain intimacy with our audience and collaborative partners during the prolonged period of social distancing.

In late April we inaugurated a new quad-weekly radio show on Dublin Digital Radio (ddr) and Cashmere Radio, Berlin. The show presents a themed selection of music, audio documents, field recordings and monologues configured in an atmosphere of self-institutionalised kinship. The show functions as a platform coalescing new and established collaborators through interventions, content sharing and performances. As a result of the crisis, the status of radio projects within O.J.A.I. has been significantly upgraded and constitutes the tip of the spear of our public engagement going forward. By years end 2020, O.J.A.I. had achieved a 17% and 12.5% audience share of radio listeners in Dublin and Berlin, respectively.

In May O.J.A.I. Sud qualified for a financial reinforcement from the Arts Council of Ireland's Covid Relief Program. The resources were directed into a publication containing a critical audit by Alicja Melzacka and a graphic overview of five years of our postal correspondence and performative paper trail. The book, designed by Zero-Desk's Carl Haase is still under construction and will be brought into the public domain in the third quarter of 2021. In July we performed a special radio broadcast in the context of RADIO-ACTIVITY (Collective Approaches to Art and Politics/ Radio as Social Sculpture) at Lenbachhaus in Munich. We invited Wolfgang Müller as our guest to talk about the late Tabea Blumenschein.

During the brief de-confinement of Summer 2021, we managed to reanimate some of our program including a performance of our Advanced Hero Worship presentation at Horst 2020 in Vilvoorde. We made series of onsite workshops commissioned by the Academy of Music, Theatre and Fine Arts in Chisinau, Moldova. The workshops were conducted in the pedestrian tunnels that run under the Moldovan capital, resulting in a radio piece presented by the Common Waves collective at The Tbilisi Architecture Biennial. In the winter, we participated in Bureaucracy, a series of work sessions exploring the creative potential of bureaucracy and administration, an initiative of Constant, Brussels. Due to re-confinement, this collaboration took place online.

In November we celebrated our fifth anniversary with a pilgrimage to the birthplace of O.J.A.I. , the German city of Wuppertal. Festivities included the drinking of Schwebebahn brand carbonated wine, the ratification of new development goals and an official O.J.A.I. photo portrait complete with oversized flowers, formal attire, and administrative embrace.

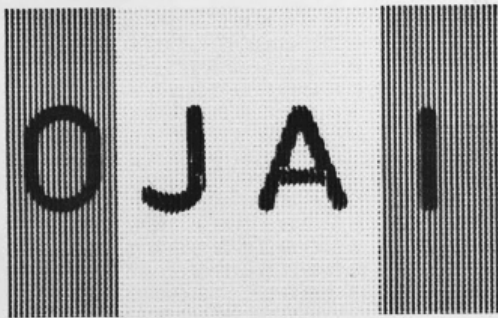

Team Audit

Dear Alicja,

Hello from Brussels. The city under lockdown is turning sullen. As I'm writing, a drone flies by the studio window blasting prerecorded announcements into the public space- Keep distance! Intimacy is unhygienic! Unauthorised communion will be met with the full force of the law. The announcement plays in French, Dutch and English in that order.

Here at the office, we are doubling down on our postal correspondence. In response to the unprecedented crisis and consequent disruption to our schedule, the postal service has been reinstated at the very centre of the practice. In a purely practical sense, the high frequency mail onslaught allows us to physically co-author drawings, official papers and graphic material while border closures and travel restrictions prevent us from being together. It's a slow, tactile process, the folds, creases, rubber stamps and signatures on paper somehow acting as a surrogate for physical intimacy.

On October 21st, we celebrate the 5th anniversary of O.J.A.I.. We'll mark the occasion with a new book, a volume presenting an overview of our postcards and letters from the last five years. We'll also publish an extended lexicon of terminology and jargon that has evolved inside our institutional frame and become the language of O.J.A.I.. Additionally, we are commissioning a text which is why I'm writing this letter.

We would like to invite you to perform an audit of the practice. If you're not familiar, auditing is an accountancy term which describes an independent examination of financial information of any entity, whether profit oriented or not, irrespective of its size or legal form. In this case, the audit will be of O.J.A.I. research, materials and methodology as opposed to financial fire power. You will have complete freedom to decide which parts of the practice you want to engage with and which paths are interesting to take in navigating the work. You are also explicitly guaranteed full creative freedom and editorial control over the audit text. Team Audit will not be responsive to, or under the instruction of O.J.A.I. management. Your *Team Audit* lanyard (enclosed) will grant you unrestricted access to O.J.A.I. archives and research materials at both the Berlin and Brussels offices.

Please let us know if the proposition is of interest.

Dear Gary, I hope you are fine. We entered into "lockdown light" a few days ago and I hate it. Remember the Estonia ship disaster, the worst after the sinking of the Titanic? New evidence shows a whole under the waterline and there is pressure to reopen the investigation. The ferry was used by the British military/MI6 to smuggle military equipment. Moldovan ship with Ammonium Nitrate (2013) resp. for explosion in Beirut 2020



Dear Comrade, looking forward to the PE-Moldova Summit 2020! My field-recording course-unit is almost finished and I enjoyed putting it together. Nothing complicated.

The owner of the ship MV RHOSSUS is a Russian business man called Igor Stechuskin (he abandoned the ship including the Ukrainian crew). It was registered in Moldova, but it sunk in the port of Beirut. In 2013 it sailed from Georgia via Turkey to the Mediterranean where it had a technical problem. The load of 3000 tons of ammonium nitrate was meant for Mozambique. In Beirut it turned out that the bill of lading was fake and Mozambique had not asked for the load. The crew lives in Cyprus.
